Spaces to Grow

Every day, Albyn pupils learn and play in spaces that shape how they see themselves and each other. Our playgrounds and social areas are at the heart of school life – places where friendships are formed, confidence is built and wellbeing begins.

Thanks to a generous legacy, we already have seed funding to begin the Spaces to Grow project. This match funding will help us raise a further £200,000 to transform our outdoor playgrounds, fitness zones and social areas. Alongside these outdoor improvements, we are also developing plans for a new £1.5 million Dining & Social Hub — an inspiring indoor space that will bring pupils, staff and families together at the heart of the school.

Every contribution will help to create environments that support wellbeing and connection – from the youngest pupils to those preparing to leave Albyn and take their next step into the world.

Bursaries and Access

Albyn has always believed in the transformative power of education. Through philanthropy, we can ensure that an Albyn education remains accessible to talented young people whatever their background.

A legacy gift has already been provided which will assist in establishing the Albyn Bursary Fund, held as a quasi-endowment within the Albyn Foundation. Our goal is to grow this to £1.25 million by 2030, using investment returns to fund bursary places each year while preserving capital for the future.

Each gift contributes to a lasting fund that broadens access, strengthens diversity and reduces reliance on fee income. Over time, the Bursary Fund will become a permanent source of opportunity - an enduring expression of Albyn's values of being self-aware, ambitious and outward-looking.
