As a **Creative Learning Assistant**, you will be an integral member of the Stopgap Dance Company's Creative Learning Team. This hands-on role offers the opportunity to gain valuable experience in inclusive dance education by supporting youth programmes, workshops, and associated administrative tasks.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support weekly sessions with our youth dance companies
- Help with administrative tasks across the Creative Learning department including IRIS & Seedbed Online
- Assist in the organisation and delivery of our annual Winter Platform event
- Provide support for external workshops and outreach events





• Provide support with social media and marketing within the creative learning team

The role is based at Farnham Maltings, with regular travel to various venues across Surrey and some opportunities for home working. A flexible working pattern will be agreed upon with the successful candidate.
