You won't find a more memorable or historic exclusive-use venue in the Highlands for your exquisitely intimate wedding than the Duke of Rothesay Highland Games Pavilion.

Surrounded by mountains and just two minutes' walk from the centre of the village of Braemar, the Pavilion was officially opened in 2018 by Queen Elizabeth II. Named in honour of HRH Prince Charles, Duke of Rothesay — now His Majesty King Charles III — it is a versatile and elegant venue, with a range of spaces well-suited for small wedding ceremonies, receptions and celebrations.

Overlooking the iconic Princess Royal and Duke of Fife Memorial Park — the home of the annual Braemar Gathering — it is the combination of Highland heritage and modern facilities that distinguishes the Highland Games Pavilion, offering a unique blend of tradition, comfort and flexibility that makes it perfect for your special occasion.
