Top Tips

1

Try to visit one of Clan's centres. You will get to see first-hand exactly how the £3,000 could help Clan, and meet with a member of our staff.



Practice, practice, practice! It may sound silly, but talking through your presentation can help you become more comfortable. Use cue cards with bullet points, headers or even doodles to remind you to cover all the important points.

Show as much enthusiasm and passion as you can within your presentation and when you're presenting.



Believe what you're saying! Having confidence while you're presenting will convince the judges on why you chose Clan as your charity.

Play to your strengths! If someone in your group is more artistic, perhaps they could add drawings or create a music track for the presentation. Try to be as creative as possible. You could include a home video, images, music or diagrams.



Stand out! Make sure your presentation isn't just text. Think about interesting presentations you've seen and what you liked about them. Or think about presentations you didn't like and use that as a guide on what to avoid!

When presenting remember to speak slowly, clearly and at a good volume. make sure to have good eye contact and body language. This will tell the judges you have worked hard, did your research and are engaged in the project.



It's okay to be nervous. It can be nervewracking standing up in front of an audience, but this is where the practice and preparation will pay off.

Why not include some audience interaction to show how powerful your social issue is. E.g. "Raise your hand if you or someone you know has been affected by cancer?"
