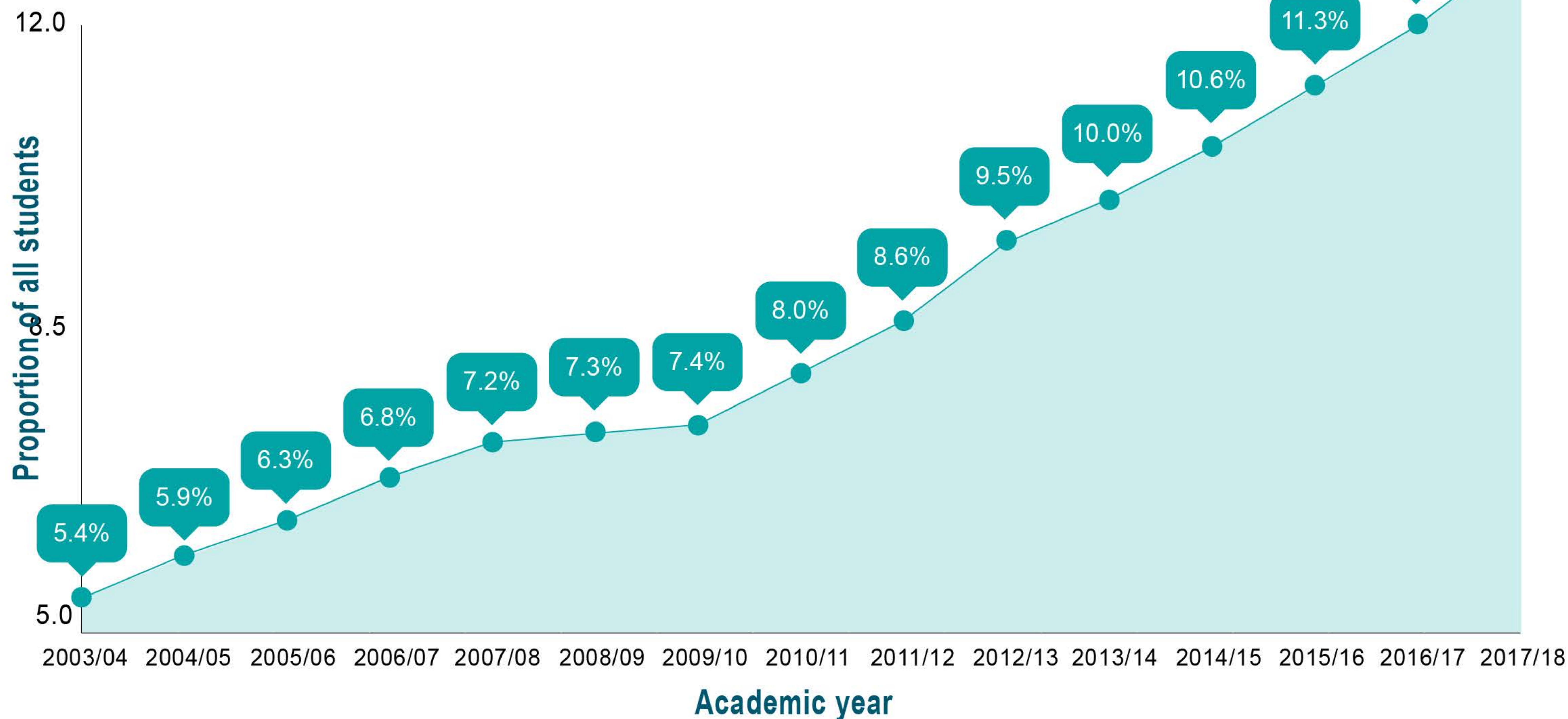

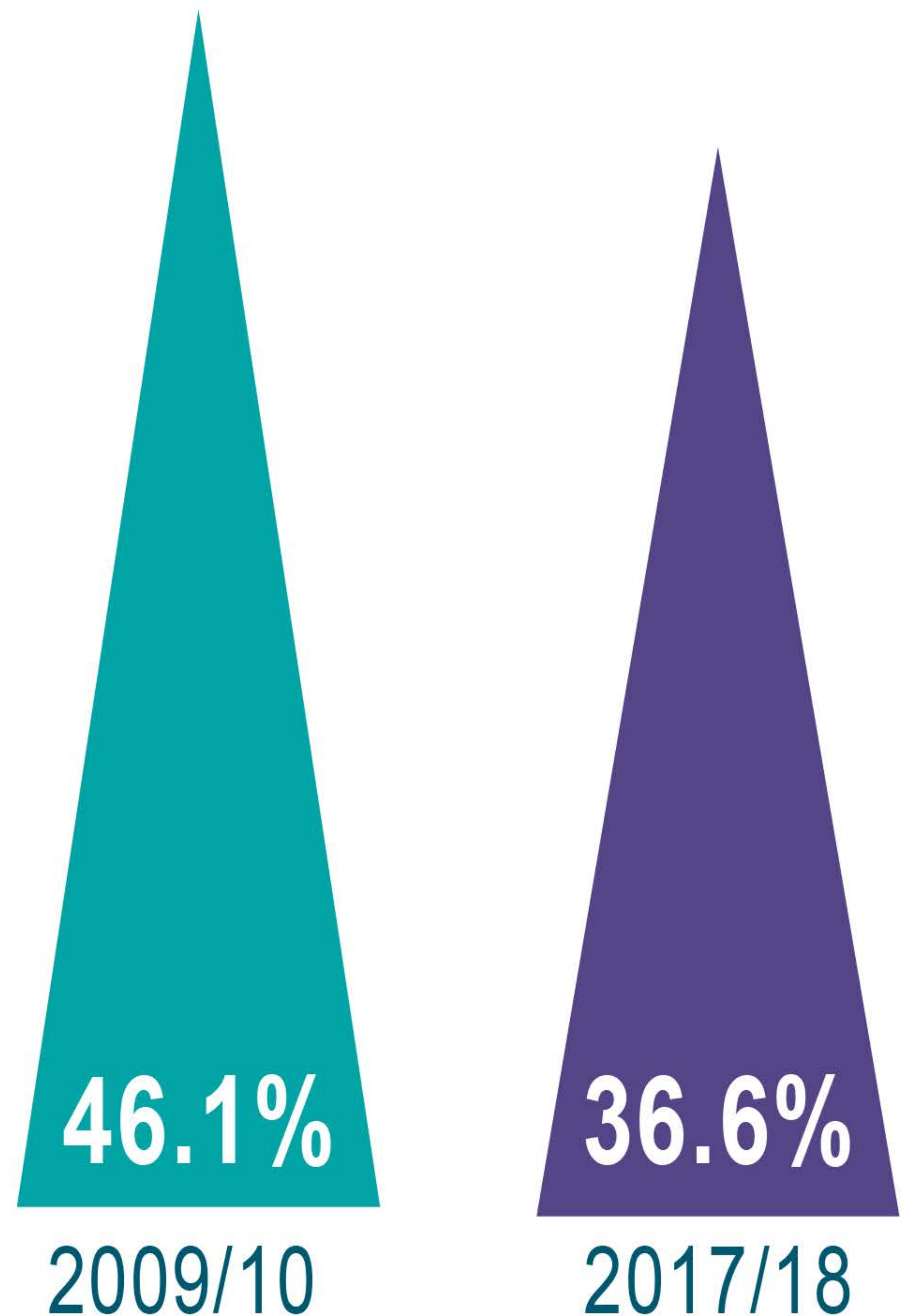

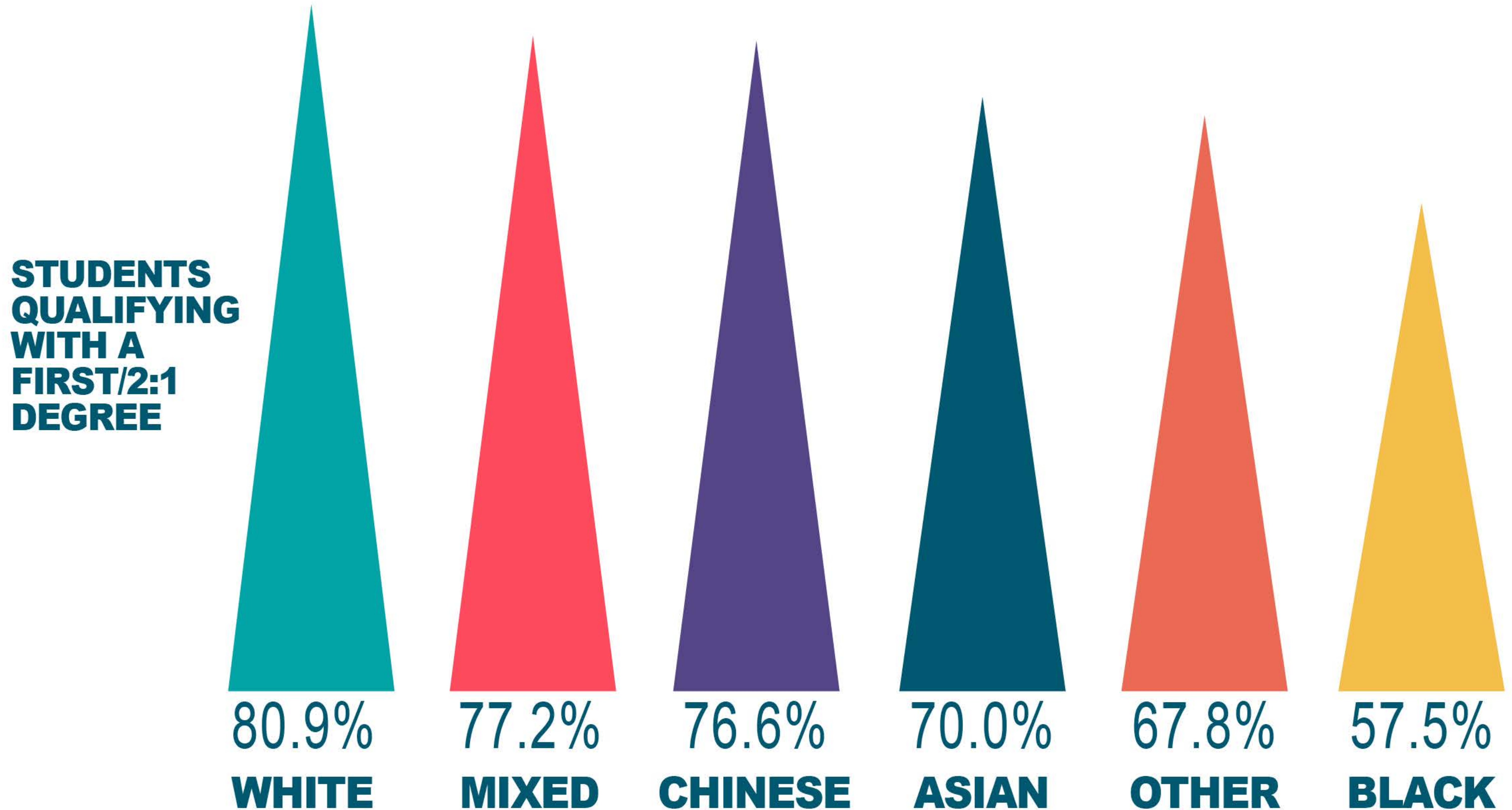

STUDENT ATTAINMENT ACROSS ETHNIC GROUPS



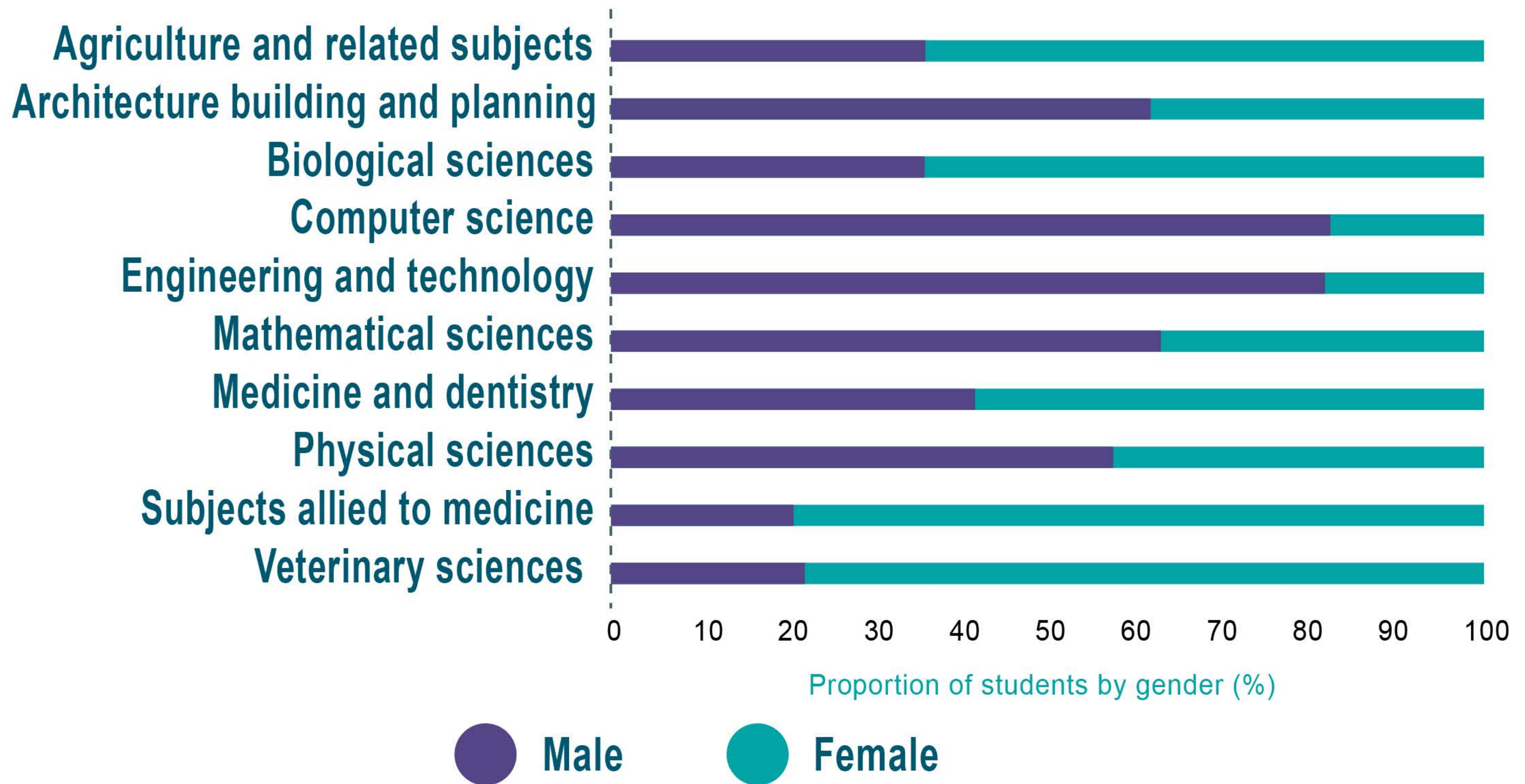
5: UK domiciled first degree undergraduate qualifiers with a First/2:1 degree by ethnic group, 2017-18

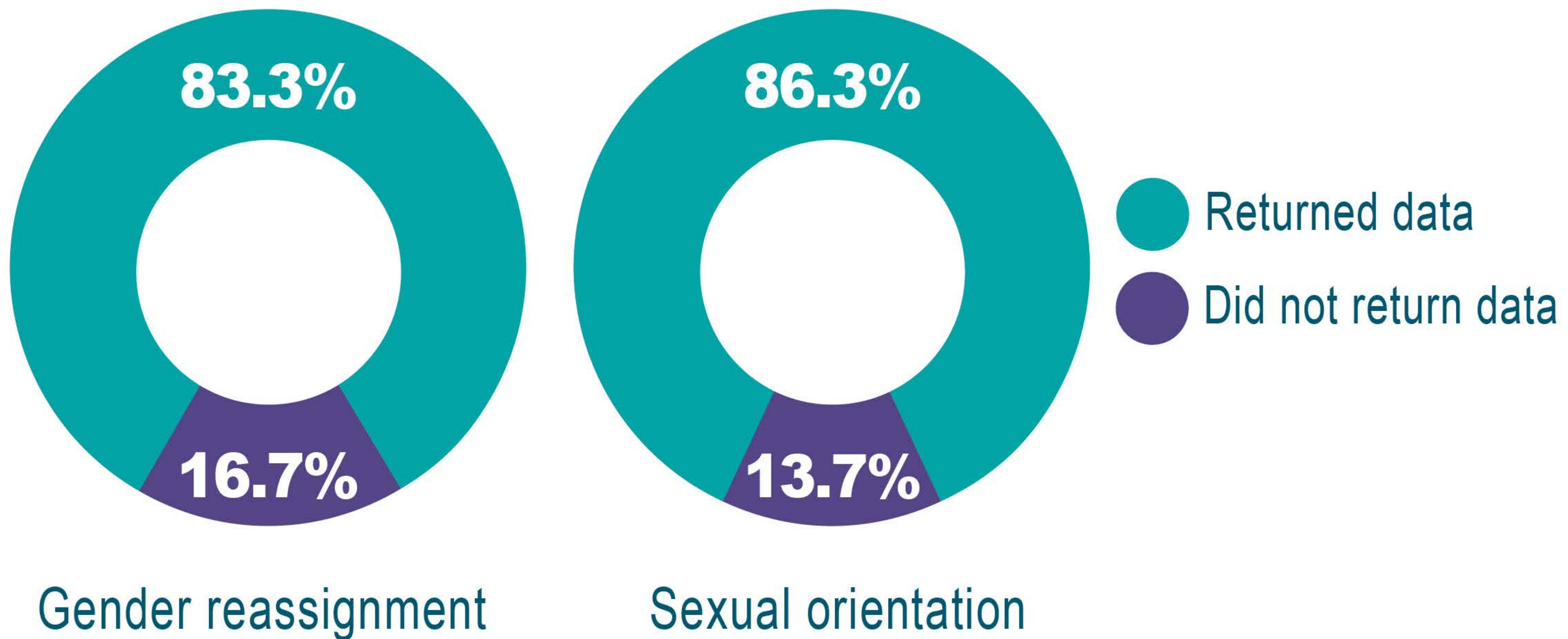

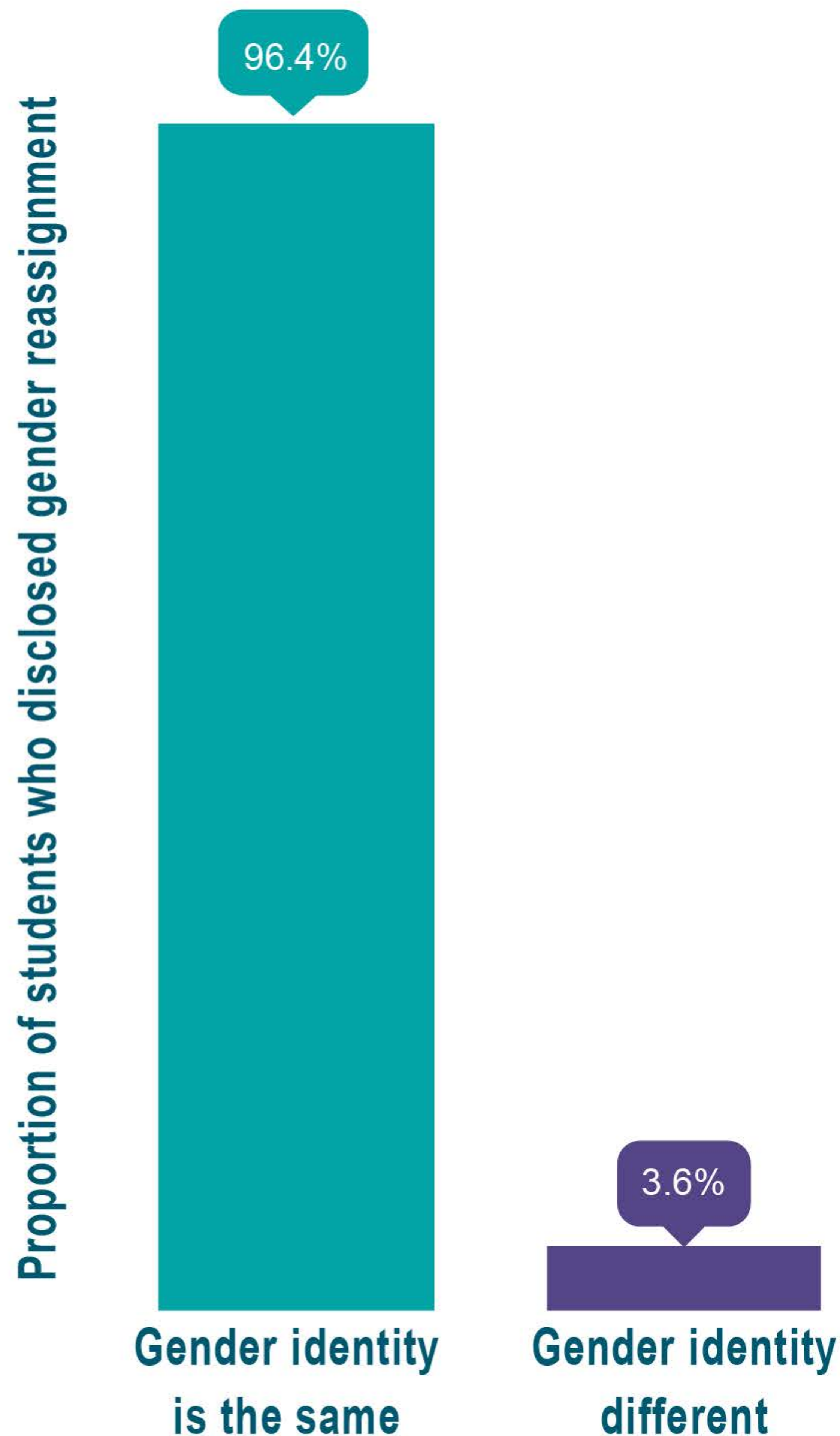

INSTITUTIONAL RETURNS FOR GENDER REASSIGNMENT AND SEXUAL ORIENTATION



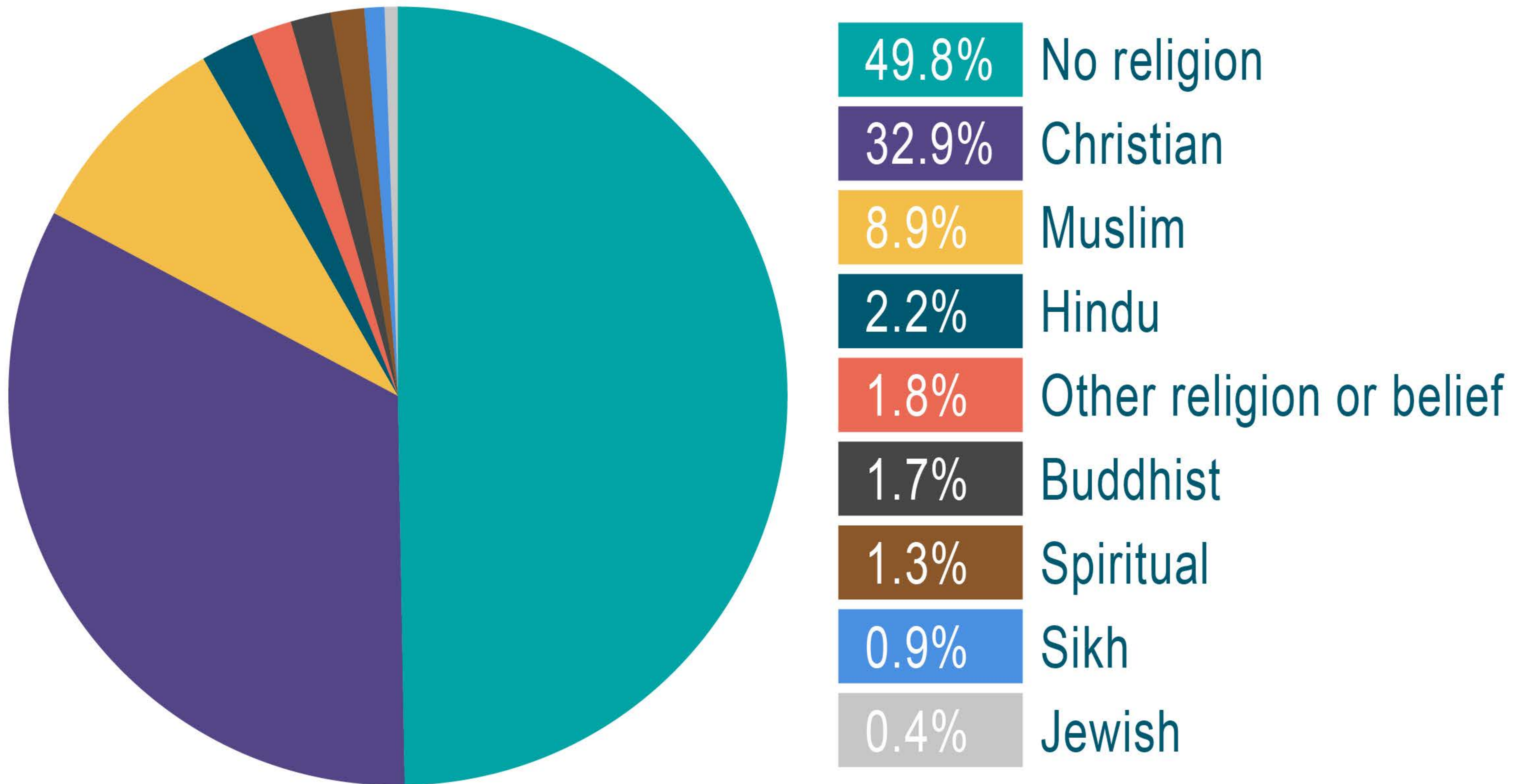
12: Returned data from HEIs by gender reassignment and sexual orientation, 2017-18



DISCLOSURE OF GENDER REASSIGNMENT BY UK HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS

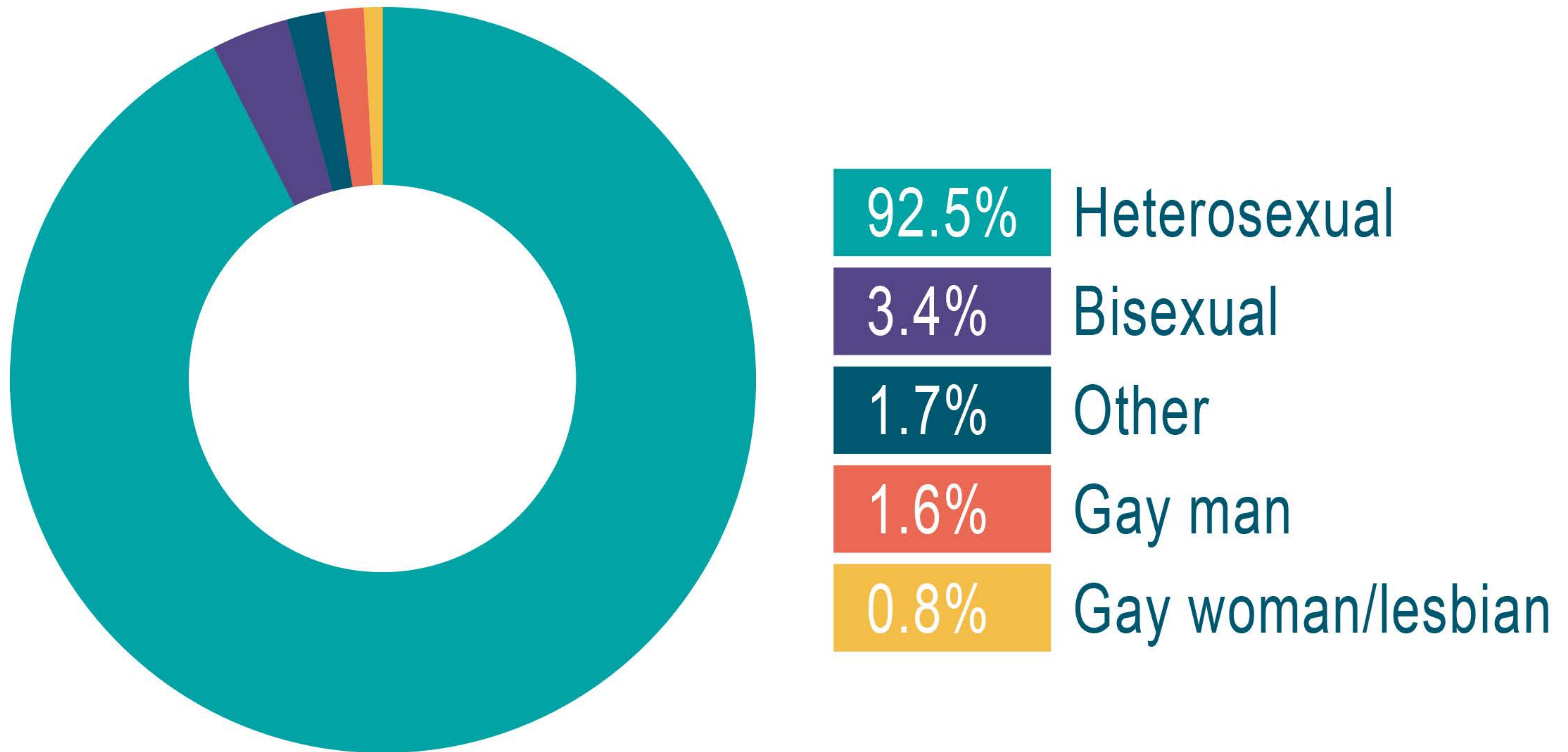

UK HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS WHO DISCLOSED THEIR RELIGION AND BELIEF



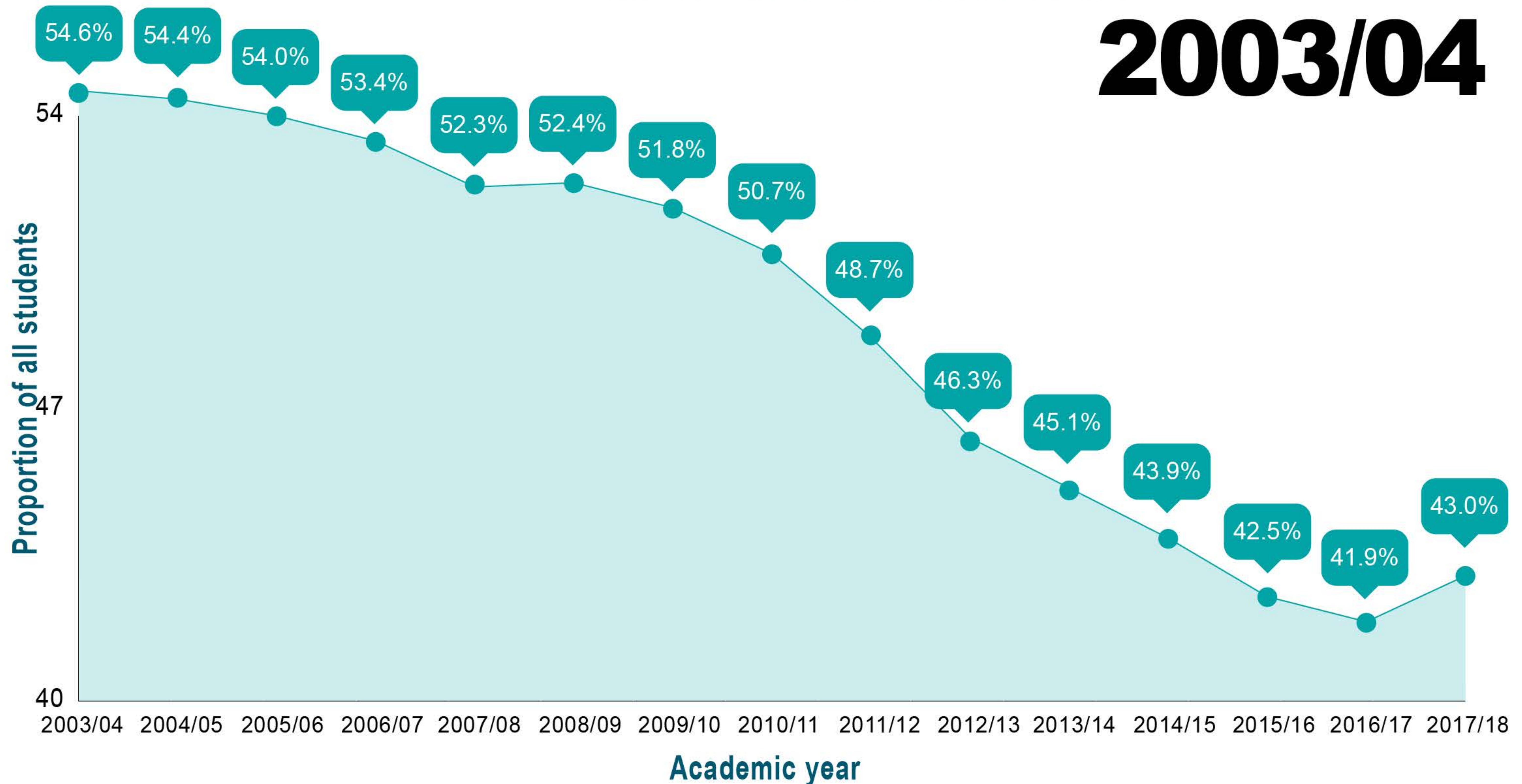
