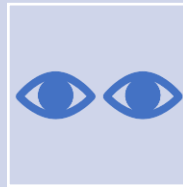
Overall preferred way of receiving feedback

Written details – 59%

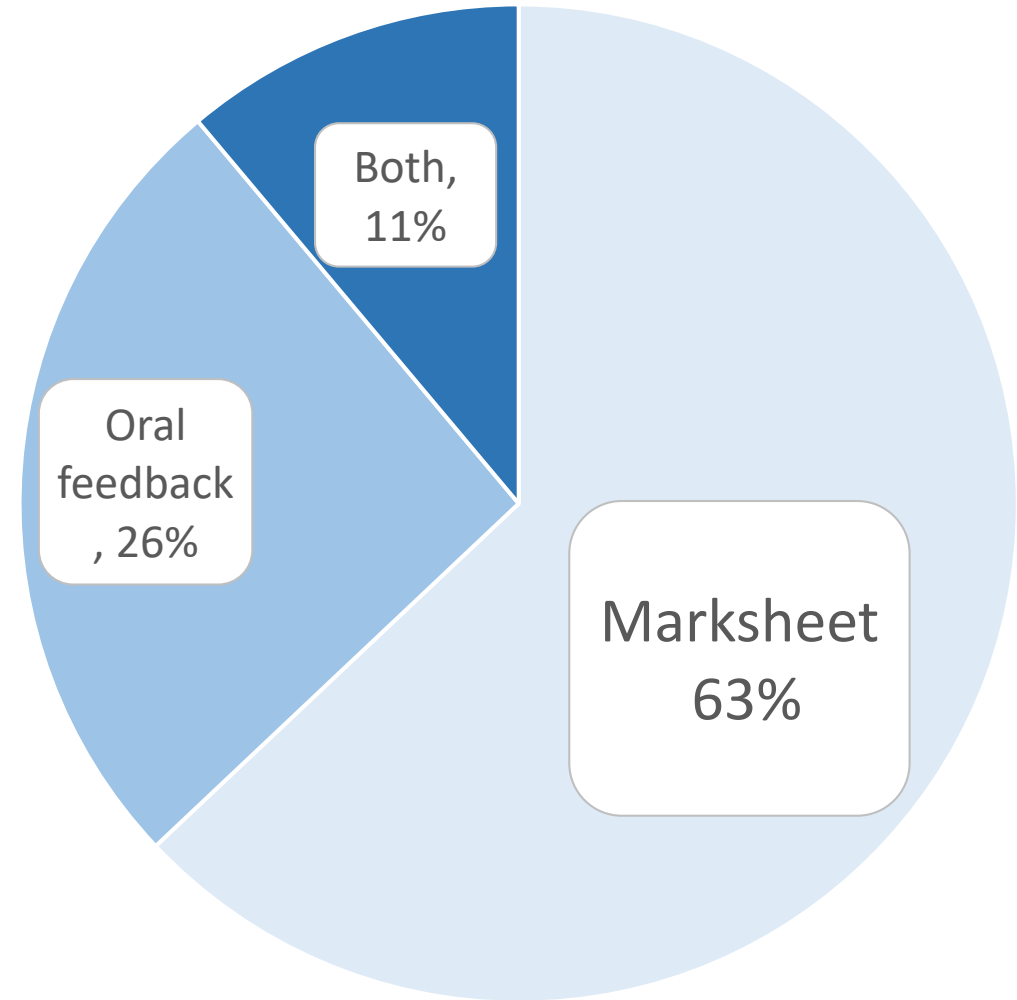

Ass 1a- Role play – Oral and marksheet

- Oral immediate feedback – 93%
- Marksheets – 77%
- Most Valuable

 2. Oral feedback

Ass 1b – Portfolio Recommendation

– *Detailed mark up in text*

Preferred choice of feedback	Positive feelings towards the type of feedback provided	Negative feelings towards the type of feedback provided
Detailed mark up in text	88%	12%
Summary feedback	41%	59%
Mark sheet	59%	41%

Ass 2a – Successful Investor factsheet

– *Summary feedback*

Preferred choice of feedback	Positive feelings towards the type of feedback provided	Negative feelings towards the type of feedback provided
Summary feedback	81%	19%
Detailed mark up in text	37%	63%
Mark sheet	59%	41%

Ass 2b – Reflective essay

– *Oral recorded feedback*

Preferred choice of feedback	Positive feelings towards the type of feedback provided	Negative feelings towards the type of feedback provided
Oral recorded feedback	85%	15%
Detailed mark up in text	70%	30%
Mark sheet	70%	30%
