A set of shared principles to underpin inclusive and supportive intervention design and evaluation can be a useful 'sense-check' for game players. These examples may inspire your own principles: think about how to set expectations for what you want your work on student outcomes to look and feel like.

In our intervention design and evaluation planning, I / we will...

- + Promote evaluation as a collective responsibility
- + Acknowledge any differences in confidence and experience
- + Appreciate different forms of knowledge and evidence
- + Pay attention to the views of others, whilst thinking about the impact of what we say
- + Welcome supportive critique and challenge
- + Consider the needs of others in terms of access to materials and discussions
