

Good afternoon David

I hope you are well.

The A19 Downhill Lane Junction Alteration Development Consent Order was made on 16th July 2020 and came into force on 6th August 2020. Requirements 3(1), 4(1), 5(1), 7(1) and 10(1) were formally discharged on 8th September 2020. I am now seeking approval to discharge the following requirement:

• Requirement 8(1) - Surface and foul water drainage: "No part of the authorised development is to commence until for that part written details of the surface and foul water drainage system, reflecting the mitigation measures set out in the REAC including means of pollution control, have been submitted and approved in writing by the Secretary of State following consultation with the relevant planning authority on matters related to its function."
