Tell us your views on potential improvements to the A30 between Carland Cross and Chiverton Cross

In December 2014 the Government published its Road Investment Strategy (RIS) which allocated funding for the A30 Trunk Road between Carland Cross and Chiverton Cross.

The aim will be to upgrade the A30 to dual carriageway standard north of Truro, connecting together the dual carriageway sections around Bodmin in the east to Redruth bypass in the west. Coupled with the Temple to Higher Carblake scheme and smaller-scale safety enhancements on the route, this improves the A30 to a consistent standard from Camborne to the M5.

The potential improvements would support economic growth and tourism, reduce congestion and delays, and provide safety benefits.

As the first step in assessing route options the Highways Agency and Cornwall Council would like to engage with the public to capture your views regarding this route.
