

HIGHWAYS ENGLAND COMPANY LIMITED
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE A52 TRUNK ROAD (GAMSTON, NOTTINGHAMSHIRE)
(40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20XX

Highways England Company Limited (Company no. 9346363) hereby gives notice that it intends to make an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A52 Trunk Road at Gamston in the County of Nottinghamshire.

The effect of the Order would be to impose a 40 miles per hour speed limit on –

- a) the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A52 and the A6011 Radcliffe Road, at Gamston, known as Gamston Roundabout;
- b) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 between points 105 metres south and 51 metres east of the centrepoint of Gamston Roundabout; and
- c) the westbound carriageway of the A52 between points 84 metres east and 105 metres south of the centrepoint of Gamston Roundabout.
