**THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND COMPANY LIMITED (A590 TRUNK ROAD CROSS-A-MOOR IMPROVEMENT SCHEME) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2021**

1. I am to inform you that the Secretary of State for Transport has confirmed the above named Side Roads Order with modifications.
2. The Order will come into force on the date on which the Secretary of State publishes notice of their confirmation in the London Gazette, in accordance with paragraph 1 (1) of Schedule 2 to the Highways Act 1980. I enclose for your information and distribution to any parties you think fit, a copy of the Notice of Confirmation of the Order which is due to be published on 29 July 2021. Arrangements have also been made by the Secretary of State for publication of the Notice in the Barrow Mail. Highways England may wish to check that the Notice does appear in the local newspaper on its scheduled date and on which date Highways England may also be seeking to publish notice of confirmation of any related Compulsory Purchase Order.
3. In confirming the Order, the Secretary of State has relied on the information that you have provided, as contained in the Order and any related plans, diagrams, statements or correspondence, as being factually correct. The confirmation of the Order is given on this basis.
4. Could you please arrange for a copy of the confirmed Order to be made available at the places used for deposit for public inspection at making stage.
5. A separate letter regarding the associated Compulsory Purchase Order is enclosed.
