HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND COMPANY LIMITED (A590 TRUNK ROAD  
CROSS-A-MOOR IMPROVEMENT SCHEME) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2021**

THE SECRETARY OF STATE for Transport hereby gives notice that on 14 July 2021 he has confirmed, with modifications, the above Order which was made by Highways England under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorise Highways England to –

- (a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering),
- (b) stop up highways,
- (c) construct new highways,
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises

all on, or in the vicinity of, the A590 Trunk Road which Highways England propose to improve from the junction with Main Road and Cross-A-Moor for a distance of approximately 330 metres.

A copy of the above-mentioned Order and of the plans referred to therein has been deposited and may be seen free of charge at Ulverston Library, King's Road, Ulverston, LA12 0BT. The availability of hard copy deposit documents is subject to Ulverston Library remaining open and no further COVID-19 restrictions being put in place. ANY PERSON aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of any provision within all or any of the Orders on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 29 July 2021, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of all or any of the Orders or of any provision included.
