Signs and signals tested between junctions 8/9-12

Testing is currently being carried out on all signs and signals between junctions 8/9 to 12. Motorway message signs are set at 50mph speed limit with a “workforce in road” notice and sign.

All other motorway speed signs are also set with a 50mph limit while our roadworks remain in place.

The majority of the work is now taking place during overnight work between junction 8/9 to 12 as we approach the completion of work.

Work between junction 3 to 8/9 continues with weekend closures also taking place along this stretch. The newly built bridges continue to be active sites on the local network as we tie the new road alignment into the existing local roads (right).



Weekend closures

To the right, are all the upcoming weekend closures up to Easter 2021, as part of the M4 J3-12 motorway upgrade. Weekend closures are used to complete work that would not be possible otherwise e.g. extensive surfacing, complex work across multiple lanes. Closures keep drivers and our workers safe whilst upgrades take place. These closures are subject to change so always make sure to check before you travel.
