Driver education course: Fact sheet and overview

- explain types of smart motorway including associated signs, signals and technology in use
- explain the reasons for implementing smart motorways
- know how National Highways manage the road network

Drivers completing the course will have a better understanding of how technology helps keep drivers moving safely, recognise the different types of smart motorways and know and follow the signs and signals..
