## THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND (M621 MOTORWAY JUNCTIONS 1 TO 7 IMPROVEMENTS) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2019

THE SECRETARY OF STATE for Transport hereby gives notice that on 27 November 2020 he has confirmed, with modifications, the above Order which was made by Highways England Company Limited under sections 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to –

- a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering);
- b) stop up highways;
- c) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- d) provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the M621 Motorway which Highways England proposes to improve from its junction with the M62 Motorway Junction 27 to approximately 1.1 kilometres south of the centre of the M621 Motorway Junction 7 roundabout a distance of approximately 12.9 kilometres.
