ROUTES TO THE JOB

- > Entry level GCSEs at grades 9-4 or equivalent
- ONC, HNC, construction T-level or degree in commercial management or quantity surveying
- Professional membership of Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors or Chartered Institute of Building
