The battle of the nations for Babylon



This passage deals further with the great battle of the nations for Babylon, the result of which will be the destruction of the Babylonian empire. Despite this march of the armies of many nations, another One is behind all this: The Lord of hosts, the strong deliverer of His people (v34).

World history is dispensational history. And at the centre of this "divine history report" is not America, Russia or Europe, but the people of Israel.

Why is Babylon so keen to be great, to the point of being mad? The Lord mentions one reason in this chapter: Idolatry – and Satan who is behind the idols – has made them literally insane (v38).
