## Jeremiah can sleep again



Jeremiah had to announce a great deal of judgment, but now He is permitted to prophecy the glorious future of the people. This even had an effect on his sleep (v26).

The people will go through much greater suffering during the tribulation, but there will be an end for all their tears (vv15-17). The repentance of Israel of their sins moves God's heart (vv18-20). The Lord Jesus explains in the gospel of Luke that heaven rejoices when only one sinner repents, i.e. turns back to God (Luke 15:7). -Have you already repented? If not, do it now! Nothing will be lacking during the Lord's reign of peace. At last,

God can bless His people in such a way as He has always desired to (vv21-26).
