## Of what value is it to do good?



This Psalm often speaks of the righteous (singular or plural).

The ungodly hate them (vv12 and 32); but God upholds them (v17), He is always with them (v25), He saves and strengthens them (v39).

The righteous themselves are characterised by giving graciously to others from their goods (v21), although they may not have very much themselves (v16). They speak wisely, and in their heart is the word of God (vv30-31).

Are these characteristics of the righteous also found with you?

"I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken." -Never! Neither today!

87. He has never seen a righteous person forsaken by God (v25). Actually: Once, God forsook a Righteous man for three hours – the Lord Jesus. 88. The man of peace (v37).
