

A nice feast



The first few verses of today's passage show that the condition among the people of God is not the best. Many Israelites celebrate the Passover without having first cleansed themselves in the way prescribed by God. Hezekiah prays that God may forgive them (v18). But does he really pray indiscriminately, for everyone? No, he prays for all those who had prepared their heart to seek God. - Is that the case with you? God is especially interested in your heart. Make the firm decision in your heart to live with Him and for Him!

Now the Israelites experience the joy of having fellowship with God. One week isn't enough for them, and they therefore prolong their stay in Jerusalem by another week.

Have you ever been really happy, enjoying fellowship with God and not wanting to stop praising and thanking Him?
