"El Shaddai" = God Almighty → the Patriarchs (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob)

'I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by [the name of] God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.' (Ex 6:3)

'And Abram was ninety-nine years old, when <u>Jehovah</u> appeared to Abram, and said to him, I [am] the <u>Almighty God</u>' (Gen 17:1)

"Jehovah" = Who is, who was, and is to come

→ Nation of Israel (covenant relationship)

'And God spoke to Moses, and said to him, I am Jehovah.' (Exo 6:2)

'And I have also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers.' (Exo 6:4)



"Father" → Christians (family relationship, children and sons of God)

'But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeks such to worship him.

God [is] a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth.'

(John 4:23, 24)



"Father" → all Christians (family relationship)

"Jehovah" → nation of Israel (covenant relationship)

"El Shaddai" = God Almighty → Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (friendship)

"Elohim" = God the Creator → men as creatures (remote / distant)
