## A picture from the Old Testament

- Genesis 22-- Abraham offering Isaac. The Father and the Son. v.23 Rebekah is mentioned for the first time.
- Genesis 23 – Sarah's death ---Picture of Israel –
- Genesis 24—Wife for Isaac --- “my country, my kindred” v.4. v. 67 He loved her and was comforted!

# Joy

- Ps 40 v8 “I delight to do thy Will” God righteousness would be seen and God will be glorified
- Bride for His own heart. “-Present it to Himself” Eph. 5v.27
- Israel will be brought into blessing “-He will joy over thee with singing” Zep. 3 v. 17

# Bride

- Today: Bride for a day, Wife for time.
- Rev 21 v.2 Bride for eternity, Freshness of first love, affection and display
- Rev 19 v. 7 & 21 v.9 the wife will administer the Kingdom with Him.

# His headship

- Eph. 1 v.22 & Col. 1 v.18 & 2 v.19
- Nourishment ministered
- Knit together
- Increase

# His Priesthood

- How are we maintained down here?
- Nothing to do with our sins. “But if any man sin we have an advocate with the Father” (1 John 2 v.1)
- Priesthood is for our Infirmities and weakness
- Heb 2 v. 18 He suffered ..... able to succour (help)
- Heb 4 v. 15 In all points tempted ---- apart from sin.....able to sympathise (JND)
- Heb 7 v. 25 He ever liveth to make intercession.....able to save.

# Glory from the Father and His Exaltation

- God hath raised Him from the dead (Acts 2 v.32)
- Set Him at His own right hand (Eph. 2 v. 20)
- A name above every name (Phil. 2 v.9)
- Every knee should bow (Phil. 2 v. 10)
- Every tongue should confess that (Phil. 2 v. 11)
