## NEU Strike Action

You will be aware of the Strike action in schools across England. This further action will take place on, Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July. The strike action is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay and school funding. It is not because of any specific issues at our school.

I am writing to you in order to provide you with as much notice as possible that school will be closed to all pupils except those we feel are better placed to be in school. We can only open the school if we have enough staff on site to keep everyone safe and I have made the decision to close to pupils except those who we have been in contact with.

There will be a number of pre-planned activities that will continue thanks to the staff of the school.

Year 6 to 7 transition will take place on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July as planned.

Pupils attending these trips will know if they are involved in these activities.

Pupils attending school are expected to arrive in school uniform.

The strike action against the Government relates to rising costs in school and the lack of funding to support children's education.

**Therefore, as a direct result of these issues, many teachers in schools across the country will be choosing to strike. Not for their own pay particularly, but because they fear for the education profession in general and the impact sustained underfunding is having on their pupils and your children.**

Finally, I would like to pay tribute to the teachers and support staff in our school. They work tirelessly for the good of every child in their care as well as our entire community. They give their time freely and care immensely about the children they work with.

Please be assured we are all **committed to providing a safe and secure environment for your child as well as delivering high-quality teaching in the classroom.**
