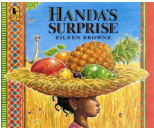
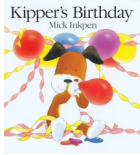
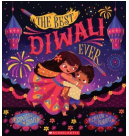
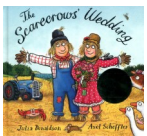
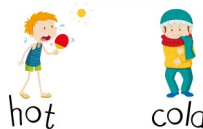


Tasty foods/Celebrations - EYFS Home Learning - Knowledge Organiser
