Now that your child has completed a term and a half of this academic year 2025-26 at The Bemrose School, we have shared two pupil level reports with you regarding their achievement and their attitude towards their learning and school. Your child's target has been calculated either by using Key Stage 2 Test Results and Teacher Assessments, or by an initial assessment of their attainment in a particular subject. This target acts as a minimum expectation around performance from their starting point for their Key Stage 3 education from which we will measure their progress from over the next three years.

These are minimum expectations and we expect children to meet and exceed these. If pupils have been scored with a 1 or a 2 for the areas that make up their attitude to their learning, we would expect them to have a good chance of meeting our expectations. Pupils do not naturally progress in this incremental way; it is natural for subject leaders to reset higher targets for some students during the year as they develop deeper understanding of their students. Other students may fall slightly short of these targets this year and develop faster next year.

You will have the opportunity to discuss your child's progress in more detail with their subject teachers in June 2026 following a third data led report.

A copy of these targets and their progress is also available in your Arbor app if you have this downloaded.

On Tuesday 10th March there will be a drop-in session in the school library from 9.30-11am and an afternoon session 2.30-3.30pm to support parents and carers understanding of the reports and how we use Arbor with Mr Rowe and Ms Woodhouse.
