So much more than just a Motor Museum!

How it used to be!

Located inside a purpose-built home in the South Cumbrian village of Backbarrow, the Lakeland Motor Museum boasts a collection of more than 150 classic cars and motorbikes, alongside a further 30,000 motoring exhibits.

Built on the site of a former Blue Mill - where a washing additive known as 'Dolly Blue' was produced, the museum offers a fascinating glimpse into years gone by.

Our car displays are flanked by faithful recreations of shop windows, with a Co-op Shop, post office and toy shop among those adding to the immersive experience.

Female fashion from the late 1800s to the 1970s, a WWI display, historic bicycle collection and an exhibition dedicated to the legend of Sir Malcolm and Donald Campbell's world record speed attempts also feature, with the latter complemented by full-size replicas of the famous land and water Bluebird craft.
