## Entertainers and Stall Holders Information

**ALL STALL HOLDERS ARE REQUESTED TO BRING THEIR OWN GAZEBO, TABLES AND CHAIRS. PLEASE NOTE WE WILL NOT HAVE ANY AVAILABLE**

**Car Parks** – To the rear of the Vicarage there are two free car parks. We would advise you use these car parks as the traffic wardens working in the High Street and Ty Nant Road are ruthless.

**Toilets** – are situated opposite the vicarage gates in Ty Nant Road.

**Refreshments** – morning coffee, lunch and an excellent afternoon tea available from the Flower Show Tea Tent.

**Vicarage Managers – Janet Spence – Tim Williams.** Please check in with either on your arrival, and they will show you to your pitch and issue you with your show pass.

**Show Security** – We have security overnight but cannot guarantee your stall will be safe.

**Thursday – 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2018** - The gardens will be open between 7.00pm and 8.00pm should you wish to set up your gazebo then or you can do it on the Friday morning.

**Friday – 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2018** - The gates will be open from 8.00am Show opens at 12.30pm  
**Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2018** Show opens at 10.00am.

### **Unloading**

For insurance purposes we have carried out a risk assessment on the event and would ask when moving your vehicles in and out of the Vicarage Gardens you do so only when under the supervision of a show official. Please drive slowly when entering and leaving the gardens especially when passing the main marquee where members of the public have access. On the Friday and Saturday the ATC boys and girls will be on hand to help you unload if you require help.

The Show will close after the Auction at approximately 5.00pm. We would appreciate you not using the main gates until after this time, there are two side gates, one positioned towards the High Street the other leading to the Parsonage and Vicarage Lane. I will leave traffic cones by the high street gate if you wish to park in the high street late afternoon, please remember the traffic wardens.

The Vicarage is now in private ownership so we ask that you respect the property and that you remove all your own rubbish, bin bags will be provided.

We recommend you bring your own comfortable chair, and we insist you enjoy yourselves.
