

RISK ASSESSMENT 1

Site or Area: All Class V Vessels

Location or Department: Steamer and Launch

Operations covered by this assessment: Mooring of Vessels/Use of Ropes

People: Maximum number of persons exposed to the hazard, frequency and duration exposure:

All Passengers (See Passenger Certificate) and Crew and every 30 minutes (approx) x 3 minute duration (approx)

Who may be harmed:

General Public and Crew

Hazards and severity: 2 (*1=minor, 2=serious, 3=very serious/fatal*)

Risk: 1 (*Likelihood: 1=very unlikely, 2=unlikely, 3=likely/very likely*)

Product of hazard severity x risk likelihood: 2 (*1,2,3 = low, 4 = medium, 6 or 9 = high*)

Actions already taken to reduce the risk:

- Crew trained in the use of ropes.
- Skipper/Master to inspect mooring ropes for wear and passengers to be kept clear when ropes are in use.

Assessment of residual risk:

- Mooring ropes snapping

Further actions required:

- Passenger to be kept clear when ropes are in use
