

RISK ASSESSMENT 3

Site or Area: All Class V Vessels

Location or Department: Steamer and Launch

Operations covered by this assessment: Passenger movement on-board/risk of trip or fall

People: Maximum number of persons exposed to the hazard, frequency and duration exposure:

All Passengers (See Passenger Certificate)

Who may be harmed: General Public and Crew and Maintenance Team and Contractors

Hazards and severity: 1 (1=minor, 2=serious, 3=very serious/fatal)

Risk: 2 (Likelihood: 1=very unlikely, 2=unlikely, 3=likely/very likely)

Product of hazard severity x risk likelihood: 2 (1,2,3 = low, 4 = medium, 6 or 9 = high)

Actions already taken to reduce the risk:

Appropriate warning sign(s) posted. Trip hazard(s) to be highlighted using appropriate material or paint

Assessment of residual risk:

Risk of elderly passengers/passengers with impaired eyesight

Further actions required:

Crew trained to assist with the above-mentioned passengers
