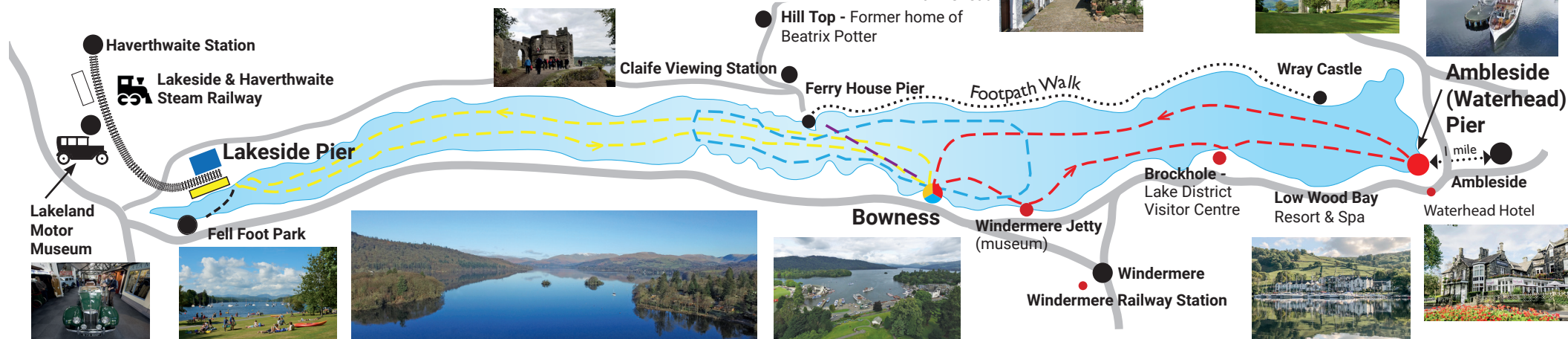

Half Lake Cruise (Red or Yellow Cruise on map)

Depart from Lakeside, Bowness or Ambleside and enjoy a spectacular voyage through some of England's most stunning scenery. This cruise can be a return journey or you can sail just one way and arrange for your own onward transport.

- One way trip takes 30 or 40 minutes
- Return journey takes 70 or 90 minutes.



Full Lake Cruise (combined Red and Yellow Cruises on map)

Sail the full ten and a half miles of Windermere and enjoy fantastic views of the Lake District mountains, secluded bays, and the magnificent historic houses that stretch along the shoreline. This journey will take place on one of our historic 'steamers'.

- One way full length trip from Lakeside or Ambleside takes 90 minutes.
