Pre-Treatment

Lamella Clarifier

Compact solid-settling system ideal for sites handling high sediment or sludge loads where space is limited.

Dissolved Air Flotation (DAF)

Removes oils, grease and suspended solids; suited to oily or high-organic wastewater from workshops, petrochemical and food industries.

Sedimentation Dissolved Air Flotation (SDAF)

Combines sedimentation and flotation to manage variable water quality where consistency is critical.

Chemical Dosing

Precision dosing to balance pH, control scaling and fouling, and support disinfection.

Primary treatment

Media Filtration

Removes suspended solids and turbidity to protect downstream equipment and improve water clarity.

Ultrafiltration (UF)

Membrane system that removes bacteria, viruses and fine particles, producing clear, pathogen-free water.

Nanofiltration (NF)

Reduces hardness, salts and organics, protecting infrastructure and extending equipment life.

Reverse Osmosis (BWRO/SWRO)

Produces high-quality potable or process water from brackish or seawater sources, ideal for remote or coastal sites.


Chemical Dosing

Precision dosing to stabilise water chemistry.



Sterilisation & Disinfection UV, Ozone and Chemical Disinfection

Wastewater

Centurion designs and delivers wastewater treatment systems built for reliability, compliance and ease of operation. Each system is tailored to your site's flow rates, wastewater characteristics and discharge requirements.

Pre-Treatment

Oily Water Separator (OWS)

Removes oil, grease and hydrocarbons from wash bays, workshops and refuelling areas.

Dissolved Air Flotation (DAF)

Removes oils, grease, and suspended solids to improve effluent quality.

Solids handling

Sludge Dewatering

Reduces water content in sludge for easier, more cost-effective disposal.

Polishing filtration for reuse

Media Filtration & Ultrafiltration (UF)

Polishing processes that remove fine solids, bacteria and viruses for clear, reusable water.

Biological Treatment

Sequential Batch Reactor (SBR)

Flexible biological treatment for domestic or light industrial wastewater. Ideal for remote or low-maintenance applications.

Membrane Bioreactor (MBR)

Combines biological and membrane treatment to achieve Class A+ effluent. Suitable for reuse in irrigation, dust suppression and firewater.

Case studies



Client: Karratha Airport | Karratha, Western Australia
Project: Wastewater treatment upgrade

Karratha Airport, a regional hub in WA, needed to upgrade its wastewater system to improve compliance and reduce reliance on fresh water.

Centurion supplied and installed two 50kL Sequencing Batch Reactors (SBRs), a 50kL buffer tank, and a 100kL/day Ultrafiltration (UF) unit. The system transforms raw sewage through biological and membrane treatment into high quality water suitable for reuse.

The treated water now supports toilet flushing, gardens, and lawns across the airport, saving potable water and improving sustainability. Built for harsh conditions, the solution delivers reliable performance, ease of maintenance, and long-term efficiency

Client: Water Corporation | Crankbook, Western Australia
Project: Water treatment plant upgrade



Centurion was engaged to upgrade the Cranbrook Water Treatment Plant (WTP) in WA, which sources raw water from two dams with artificial catchments. The WTP had ongoing water quality issues that required costly carting during poor quality events. The existing bulk chlorine dosing system also risked non-compliance, and the client needed the plant to meet Level 4 treatment standards for public health protection.

Over 2.5 years, we designed and built a comprehensive upgrade including pH correction, coagulation, disc filtration, ultra-filtration, UV disinfection, and chlorination modifications – ensuring enhanced capacity and compliance.


The upgraded plant increased capacity to 247 kL per day within 16-hours, achieved Level 4 water source compliance, and we added a new 60 kL filtrate tank to provide additional storage and support future demand.

Client: Local Government owned utility | SE Queensland
Project: Electrochlorination using the Hyprolyser®

A local government-owned utility in SE Queensland faced issues with poor chlorine retention and no site power at its facility. To address this, they set out to build a solar-powered, state-of-the-art plant with electrochlorination at its core. We were selected for our proven expertise in chlorination and exclusive Australian distribution of the Hyprolyser® system.

Our solution included two 2.2kg/hr Hyprolyser® units, storage tanks, dosing systems, and advanced chlorine/pH analysis. The customised system delivered an environmentally friendly, safe alternative to chemical goods, ensuring reliable water treatment without reliance on bulk chlorine
