

M Leader – Mission

Giving each person, in all the Mount Barker region, every opportunity to respond to Jesus.



PURPOSE

To motivate and equip God's people to share the gospel so that together we are seeing people saved as they respond to Jesus in repentance and faith.

OUR CONVICTIONS ABOUT THIS PURPOSE

God is at work in the world and he wants us to join him. We are invited to participate in the greatest, most diverse, most significant cause in history - the building of his kingdom. All Christians, compelled by the love of Christ, are witnesses to his life, death and resurrection.

KEY ELEMENTS

- **MISSION PARTNERS** - Excite and remind Trinity members of their gospel partnership in world mission and local mission with our church's mission partners.
- **EVENTS** - Motivate, equip, and involve God's people in mission by planning and overseeing evangelistic events, including Christmas events, and Simply Christianity.
- **TRAINING** - Enable Trinity members to use their gifts most effectively and fruitfully in mission, by facilitating training for evangelism.

KEY REQUIREMENTS

CHARACTER

- Living out a personal relationship with Jesus.
- Above reproach in all aspects of personal life.
- Practicing spiritual disciplines and be growing in spiritual maturity.

CONVICTION

- Agree with the Trinity Church Statement of Beliefs and Objects.
- Regular in attendance at Sunday services and actively involved in the life of Trinity Church.
- Have completed *God, Church & Me*.
- Have a love for lost people and a longing for them to come to saving faith in Jesus.
- Convinced of the significance of the Great Commission of Jesus to all believers.

COMPETENCY

- Able to identify, develop, and lead leaders, who can identify, develop, and lead leaders.
- Relational warmth and a demonstrated ability to relate to people of any class background, culture or social group.
- Capable of exciting and inspiring people to become deeply involved in God's mission in the world, whatever the cost.
- Operates with a high level of attention to detail.
- Able to identify areas where Trinity members need to be trained and equipped for mission.
- Able to work well in a team, and to contribute well to discussions and decisions.
- A willingness to learn and be taught, and to constantly review and improve processes and practices.

SUPPORT PROVIDED

TRAINING

- On-the-job training and feedback.
- 1:1 catch up with Senior Pastor every term.
- M-Leaders group meeting with Senior Pastor every second month.
- Trinity Network Leadership Conference annually.
- M-Leader support and collaboration with M-Leaders from other Trinity Churches.
- Other Trinity Network training events.

RESOURCES

- Support and direction from Senior Pastor and Leadership Team.
- Being part of a team ministry environment.
- Trinity Resources Library on the church website.
- Promotional, devotional, training, and other from mission partners.
- Admin and promotional support for all events.
- Orientation to any tools required for your role (e.g. CCB, Planning Center, Google Drive, Slack).

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Mission M-Leader role is primarily one of oversight and facilitation, working with our Mission Partners and their organisations, our Area Leaders, Team Leaders, and those in the church family who run events.

- **MISSION PARTNERS** - Involve the Trinity family in gospel partnership with our Mission Partners, by overseeing and maintaining regular communication with our Mission Partners, and their sending organisations.
Work with the Magnification Team to distribute prayer points and requests from Mission Partners for people's private prayers, and for incorporation into our prayers when we gather.
Offer support and care to our Mission Partners, giving the church opportunity to meet practical needs, before, during, and after their ministry.
Promote events run by Mission Partner organisations that will equip and excite Trinity members for mission.
- **EVENTS** - Oversee the running of Simply Christianity twice each year.
With the Senior Pastor, plan and run Simply Christianity for Cornerstone College students once a year.
Encourage and equip Trinity members to invite their friends and family who don't know Jesus along to evangelistic courses and events.
Build teams to plan, develop, and lead evangelistic events, including Christmas events and Family Carols.
Coordinate the various ministry teams who serve in evangelistic events, caring for their members, and facilitating helpful planning, promotion, rehearsals, etc.
- **TRAINING** - Contribute to the evangelistic endeavours of church members, by sourcing and facilitating mission training, such as in 1:1 Bible reading, preparing and giving a testimony, writing evangelistic talks, and answering tough questions.
Encourage and support the evangelistic prayers and conversations of the Trinity family by promoting the use of the 5 Friends 5 Ways cards.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Meet with a representative of Mission Partner organisations once a year.
- Meet with our Mission Partners when possible on home assignment, or once a year for local Mission Partners.
- Meet with the Senior Pastor once each term.
- Plan and promote evangelistic events, and meet with those coordinating them as necessary to ensure their effectiveness.
- Visit and share with the Leadership Team once each year and provide a written report to the LT once each year.
- Share a written Mission Update with the church family prior to the AGM each year.
- Meet with Trinity Network M-Leaders as is helpful throughout the year.
- Lead, support, and communicate with Area Leaders and Team Leaders within the Maturity Purpose in an ongoing, regular way.
- Promote a pattern of witnessing to the gospel of Jesus as a regular way of life for all Christ's people.
