



Notice from CNA - 8/9/2025

We would like to inform you of an urgent weather alert for the coming days:

Forecast period: From early morning **Tuesday, September 9, 2025** until **Thursday**

Delicate situation: The storm episode may be associated with severe phenomena.

According to the latest mesoscale models (ECMWF, GFS, AROME, HARMONIE-AROME) and reference channels (Climabalears, Meteodadesbalears), the following conditions may occur:

- Downbursts with wind gusts exceeding **90 km/h**
- Severe squalls at sea and possible *funnels* over land
- Waterspouts (*tornados over the Balearic Sea*)
- Clusters of thunderstorms over the sea
- Hail larger than **2 cm**
- Possibility of convective train
- Possible mesoscale convective system (MCS)

The event is expected to be **intense, irregular, and prolonged (30–36 h)**, with short lulls between storms. The strongest episodes may bring locally torrential rainfall, especially in the **Serra de Tramuntana** and the **Eastern coast of Mallorca**, though **Mallorca and Menorca** are at general risk.

Recommendations:

- Avoid going to sea whenever possible.
- Take maximum precautions with all boats and equipment.
- Follow the **live radar** and reliable official/meteo channels for updates.
