Notice of Race ('NoR')

12th - 14th September 2025

The Organising Authority ('OA') is the Club Nautic Arenal Mallorca in conjunction with the MED Cape 31 Regional Class Authority.

The notation 'NP' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule this changes RRS 60.1.

This Appendix should be read in conjunction with the Notice of Race for the Cape 31 MED Race Circuit 2025: https://cms.cape31class.com/racing/series/9 ('Circuit NoR') to form the NOR for Cape 31 MED Round 5.

A term in *italics* refers to a definition in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2025 – 2028 ('RRS') and other than a title, a term in **bold** refers to a definition in the World Sailing Equipment Rules of Sailing 2025 - 2028 ('ERS').

1. Rules

1.1. See Circuit NoR 1.

2. Sailing Instructions

2.1. The Sailing Instructions shall be available no later than Wednesday 10 September on the online ONB.

3. Communication

- 3.1. The ONB for this Round shall be online available at https://cms.cape31class.com/racing/regatta/57.
- 3.2. All boats shall carry a marine VHF radio capable of receiving international VHF channels.
- 3.3. On the water, the Race Committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.

4. Eligibility and Entry

4.1. Eligible boats and charterers may enter by completing online registration at https://cms.cape31class.com/racing/regatta/57 by the 5 September.

10. Equipment Inspection

10.1. Boats shall be subject to post race inspection and crew weighing as specified in the Sailing Instructions.

11. Clothing and Equipment

11.1. See Circuit NoR 11.

12. Venue

12.1. The Venue is Palma, Spain.

13. Courses

13.1. The course will be windward leeward buoyed courses set from a committee vessel with an offset windward mark.

14. Penalty System

- 14.1. The first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or RRS 31 in an incident while racing."
- 14.2. In RRS 44.2 insert after the first sentence: "However, on a windward/leeward course, if Mark 1a (windward spreader mark) is set, a boat shall take a penalty for an incident in the zone around Mark 1 or on the leg between Mark 1 and Mark 1a, as soon as possible after leaving the zone around Mark 1a".
- 14.3. For breaches of any rule, other than a rule of RRS part 1 and 2 the penalty shall be at the discretion of the protest committee unless the penalty is stated in the rule itself. The penalty shall be applied to all races in which the rule was broken. The protest committee shall be guided by the World Sailing Discretionary Penalty policy forming part of the World Sailing Jury Policies found on the World Sailing website (https://www.sailing.org/our-sport/race-officals/international-judges-resources/), as may be amended by World Sailing.

15. Scoring

15.1. If less than 5 races are completed and scored, a boat's series score shall be the sum of her race scores. If 5 or more races are completed and scored, a boat's series score shall be the sum of her race scores excluding her worst.

16. Support Person Vessels

16.1. *Support Person* Vessels shall carry appropriate marine VHF equipment to be able to receive communications channel 72.

17. Chartered or Loaned Vessels

17.1. Not Used.

18. Haul-Out Restrictions

18.1. See Circuit NoR 19.

19. Diving Equipment and Plastic Pools

19.1. Not Used.

20. Data Protection

22.1. Each participating boat shall be adequately insured, with cover of at least €uro 1,500,000.00 against third party claims per claim.
