

SNOWBALL CUSHION

BUILD-A-BLOCK™

DRUNKARD'S PATH

YOU WILL NEED

- 27" x 20" of white fabric
- 9" x 9" of navy fabric
- 20" x 10" of grey fabric
- 9" x 9" of light blue fabric
- 9" x 9" of turquoise fabric
- 9" x 20" of orange fabric
- Cushion Pad 18" x 18"
- Gemini™ Build-A-Block™ Drunkard's Path die set
- Gemini™ die-cutting machine
- Sewing machine
- Co-ordinating thread
- Basic sewing kit

CUTTING PREPARATION

- Die-cut 16 medium quarter circles
- Die-cut 16 medium corners
- Cut top and bottom border strips measuring 1.5" x 16.5" from orange fabric
- Cut side borders strips measuring 1.5" x 18.5" from orange fabric
- Cut two backing panels measuring 18.5" x 10.75" from white fabric



HOW TO MAKE

1 Sew a medium corner to a medium quarter circle. Mix and match colours to create the random look to your finished cushion as shown. Repeat this process a further 15 times **[A]**.

2 Now all your block pieces are sewn together, sew them right sides together to form four larger blocks **[B]**.

3 Sew the four blocks from Step 2 right sides together **[C]**.

4 To finish the cushion front, sew the 1.5" x 16.5" strips right sides together along the top and bottom edge of the block.

5 Sew the 1.5" x 18.5" strips right sides together down each side of the cushion block. Your cushion front is now complete.

6 Take one backing panel and fold it over lengthways by ¼" and again by ¼". Edge-stitch to hold the folded fabric in place. Repeat this step with the remaining back panel.

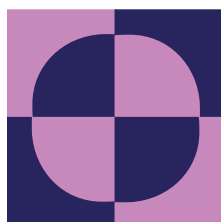
7 Lay one backing panel along the top edge of the cushion front right sides together and the remaining backing panel along the bottom edge of the cushion. Ensure that the neat folded edges of the backing panels meet in the middle to create the envelope opening.

8 Stitch around all 4 sides of the cushion cover and turn the cover through the envelope opening. Insert the cushion pad inside the cushion cover to finish.
