

Code of Conduct

Leisure & Social

It is hoped that members will fully enjoy their involvement in CSSC activities and find each event that they participate in to be well organised. The following CSSC Code of Conduct has been introduced to act simply as a reminder to everyone involved in any CSSC activity that they all have a responsibility for the way in which CSSC social and leisure activities are practised. All affiliated associations and councils are being encouraged to adopt this code for their own activities which could range from a theatre trip to a gala ball.

Know the itinerary of the event – where you need to be and what, if anything, you need to provide/bring with you. If you are unsure about anything ask the organisers before the event for further information or assistance. Ensure that the organisers are aware of any special requirements that you require when attending the event (e.g. access for wheelchair, special dietary needs etc).

Be on time – as a basic courtesy, for all aspects of the event. Know the itinerary and how it affects you. No one appreciates a poor timekeeper.

Unacceptable behaviour

- The use of illegal drugs by an individual at any CSSC event will not be tolerated and could be reported (as appropriate) to the police. Should a CSSC member or their guest be found to have used or supplied illegal drugs at an event they will be asked to leave (further action could be taken by the organisers at a later date which could include a ban on attending similar events)
- Any member(s) or their guests who, in the opinion of the CSSC organisers of the event or the management or the host venue, is causing an undue disturbance or is likely to attract criticism of the event through inappropriate behaviour or the misuse/over-consumption of alcohol, will be required to modify their behaviour or leave the event.

Responsibilities of attendees – as representatives of CSSC Regions, Area Associations or clubs, all attendees should ensure that their own behaviour, and that of their guests, enhances the reputation of the organisation.
