The Safer Business Network have also been commissioned by the GLA and MOPAC to carry out a scoping exercise to identify opportunities to grow the support base for the [Women's Night Safety Charter](#) and attract new signatories from a variety of stakeholder groups, including licensed premises, transport, organisations managing the public realm, and other schemes and initiatives. They will also be developing training and resources to assist signatories to deliver their commitment to the Charter.
