Disruption of business deliveries; road closure from 28th June for 10 weeks - on part of St John's Hill

I wanted to alert you to the news that the bridge on St John's Hill - next to the Brighton Yard entrance of Clapham Junction station - is going to be closed for 10 weeks from 28 June for essential works.

Pedestrians will still be able to walk over the bridge, but it will be closed to all vehicles. The closure is just after the Brighton Yard entrance up to Plough Road (the crossroads).

The Council have informed me that you will be receiving a letter from them detailing the works, but I wanted to alert you in the first instance. Please could you let me know if, and how, this will affect your deliveries.

As yet, we have not received a map from TFL to show how bus routes will be diverted, but I will notify you in due course.
