



The JORVIK Group is a collection of York's most popular and unique attractions. Starting in 1984 with the opening of the world-famous JORVIK Viking Centre, which takes visitors back in time to the 10th century Viking city, the group has now grown to include 5 attractions, including:

- **DIG: An Archaeological Adventure**, a hands-on, interactive archaeology experience aimed at children and families.

- **Barley Hall**, a restored medieval townhouse, tucked away in the centre of York. Once home to the Pryors of Nostell and the 15th century Lord Mayor of York, William Snawsell, visitors are invited to make themselves at home by sitting on the furniture and handling the objects.

- **The Richard III & Henry VII Experiences**, located at opposite ends of the ancient

fortifications of the city's 'Bars' or gatehouses to the walls, each attraction explores the impact the last Plantagenet King of England, Richard III and the first Tudor monarch, Henry VII had on the city of York.

Covering over 2,000 years of the city's history from the Romans to Victorians, The JORVIK Group uses archaeology to bring the stories of the past to life.

The JORVIK Group of Attractions is owned by York Archaeological Trust, an independent education charity which investigates the past for the benefit of communities today and future generations. The JORVIK Group follows the values of the Trust; working to discover and present history in a way that is both engaging and informative, bringing history to life.
