CONTENTS

Each page consists of a practice letter, first in lower case letters then in capital letters. The lower case letters are in blocks which help the pupils form the letters properly.

The letters are in the following order:

but could be taught in any order.

The capital letters each have a block where learners draw a picture starting with that letter of the alphabet.

Instead of drawing, they could also paste a picture.

THIS IS NOT A PHONICS BOOK, BUT A WRITING BOOK: the pictures and words used are relevant to the letter of the alphabet taught and not the sound it makes.
