AND UPON HEARING the Solicitor for the Claimants and the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) consenting

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND there being no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the said Application as appears from the Affidavit of *CHAMANJIT SINGH UPPAL DATED 11 JULY 2004* and the exhibit thereto

AND on leave being given to amend the Claim Form by adding PDC Engineering Limited as a co-Claimant and re service being dispensed with



AND the Claimants by their Solicitors undertaking that:

- (A) the company will not carry on business or operate in any way other than to take the necessary steps receive the benefit of the legal charge referred to referred to in paragraph 13 of the Witness Statement of Diarmuid Jeremiah Desmond dated the 23 April 2004
- (B) they will take no other action regarding the realisation or disposal of the assets of the Company until a liquidator has been appointed.
- (C) they will immediately upon the conclusion of the action referred to at (A) above take all steps necessary for procuring that the Company be placed in voluntary liquidation.

THIS COURT DOTH ORDER that the name of the above named PDC Construction Limited be restored to the Register of Companies

AND IT IS ORDERED that an Office Copy of this Order to be delivered to the Registrar of Companies AND pursuant to the above mentioned Act the said PDC Construction Limited is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off

AND IT IS ORDERED that the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in her official name in the

"London Gazette"

AND IT IS ORDERED that the Claimants the said PDC Construction Limited and PDC Engineering Limited do jointly and severally pay (1) to the Registrar of Companies her costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300-00 (2) to the Treasury Solicitor the sum of £756.05 inclusive of VAT being her costs for dealing with the affairs of the company whilst it was dissolved
