## 1 Accounting Policies

**Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts**

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities effective April 2008.

**Turnover policy**

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents amounts invoiced for work carried out during the period, exclusive of Value Added Tax.

**Tangible assets depreciation policy**

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Plant & Machinery - 20% Straight line

Motor Vehicles - 25% Reducing balance

Office Equipment - 25% Straight line
