

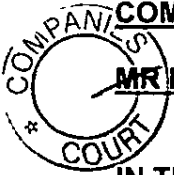

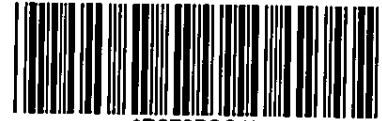

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COMPANIES HOUSE

IN THE MATTER of 1 OAK LEISURE LIMITED

-and-

IN THE MATTER of THE COMPANIES ACT 2006

UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated the 14 October 2014 of Jayne Wilson the Claimant and a creditor of the above named 1 Oak Leisure Limited (hereinafter called "the Company")

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the waiver letter from the Treasury Solicitor dated the 26 November 2014

AND the Claimant by her solicitors undertaking to

- (A) inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the litigation insofar as it is against the Company referred to in paragraph 8 of the Witness Statement of Roger James Maddocks dated the 9 October 2014 or any appeal therefrom or the conclusion of the claim against the Company by any other means

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- (B) unless the said litigation against the Company is completed in the interim, at 6 monthly intervals from the date of the order serve on the Registrar of Companies a full and sufficient Witness Statement setting out what steps have been taken to progress the said litigation insofar as it is against the Company

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) the name of the above named 1 Oak Leisure Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) the Company do continue in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation
- (3) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 07565904 Limited
- (4) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off

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- (5) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
- (6) in the event that the Claimant fails to comply with undertaking (B) above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the Claimant
- (7) the hearing fixed for the 30 January 2015 be vacated
