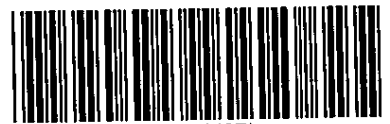

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

Through continuous working with our partners, stakeholders and funding bodies, we have been able to extend the music opportunities available to our young musicians and members. We have increased our audience size and Kuumba is a familiar name within the sector.

The children have accessed various musical established, performed at prestigious events which in turn has increased their confidence as solo artists and as a group. Our weekly club called Kuumba Klub which is growing in size which not only supports the musicians but provides a meeting place for the families. We still run our yearly Young Music Leaders and our 3 day music school. We still have firm links with the Royal Academy of Music and The Barbican Centre.

Our young musicians have grown in confidence and are able to access outside activities which support their musical learning. We have recently recruited 8 young musicians aged between 5 years to 7 years.


