## Statement of the Directors' Responsibilities

The Directors claim exemption from the requirement to be audited and deliver audited accounts to the Registrar of Companies under Statutory Instrument 1994 Numbers 1935 and 2879 as a smaller company which has a turnover less than £350,000 for the period ending 31 August 2002. The company has been dormant throughout the Financial Period ending 31 August 2002 and the Directors rely on Section 25c of the Companies Act 1985 entitling them to deliver unaudited accounts to the Registrar of Companies. The Directors confirm that they are entitled to the exemption conferred by section 246 on a small company.


