

ADMINISTRATION ORDER

UPON THE PETITION of Craig Ferguson & Co. LLP Limited of Queen Anne House, 4 and 6 New Street, Leicester LE1 5NT (a creditor of the above-named company) ("**Company**") presented to the court on 18 April 2002.

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the petitioner.

AND UPON READING the evidence.

IT IS ORDERED that during the period for which this order is in force the affairs, business and property of the Company be managed by the administrators appointed by this order pursuant to the provisions of section 8 of the Insolvency Act 1986 for the following purposes:

1. A more advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be effected on a winding-up.

AND IT IS ORDERED that Richard James Rees and Stuart David Maddison of Messrs PricewaterhouseCoopers of Victoria House, 76 Milton Street, Nottingham NG1 3QY be appointed administrators of the Company ("**Administrators**")

AND IT ORDERED that the costs of the Petitioner on and occasioned by said petition and of the report ("**Report**") pursuant to rule 2.2 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 ("**Rules**") be paid as an expense of the administration

AND IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to the provisions of rule 7.51 of the Rules and CPR 3.1(2)(a) the time for service of the petition under rule 2.7 of the Rules upon the Company and the Administrators and the holders of any debentures be abridged

AND IT IS ORDERED that any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by an administrator may be done by either or both of the Administrators.

AND IT IS ORDERED that the matter be listed for mention on 13 May 2002.
