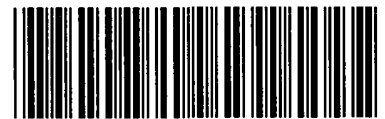





1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES**Basis of preparing the financial Statements**

The financial statements were prepared on a going concern basis.

Accounting Conventions

The historic cost convention was used in preparing the financial statements.

International Accounting Standards

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Financial Reporting Standards (IAS /IFRS).

2 NON CURRENT ASSETS

Non-current assets comprising plant and equipment are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is calculated at rates so as to write off the asset over its expected useful life. It is calculated as follows:

Plant and Equipment 20% Straight line depreciation.

3 FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSLATION

Any exchange gains or losses from the valuation of receivables and payables at the balance sheet date are taken to the Income statement. Profits or losses from fluctuating exchange rates are taken into account when calculating net income.
