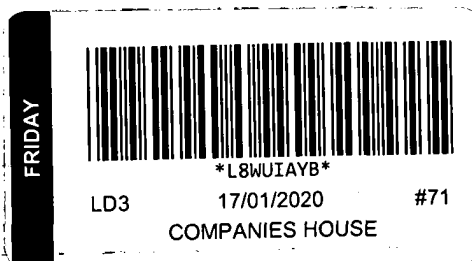




For the year ended 30 April 2019 the Company was entitled to exemption from audit under section 480 of the Companies Act 2006 relating to dormant companies.
