NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2013

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated)

1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts

1.4 Goodwill

Acquired goodwill is written off in equal annual instalments over its estimated useful economic life of twenty years

1.5 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows

Land and buildings Leasehold	5% straight line
Plant and machinery	20% straight line
Computer equipment	30% straight line
Fixtures, fittings and equipment	20% straight line
Motor vehicles	25% straight line

1.6 Leasing

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged against income on a straight line basis over the lease term

1.7 Stock

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

1.8 Revenue recognition

Revenue comprises the fair value for the sale of goods and the provision of services to outside customers, excluding VAT, and is recognised when the significant risks and rewards of ownership have been transferred to a third party

1.9 Deferred taxation

Deferred taxation is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted

Overdrawn directors loans incur interest at the current official rate of 4%. Directors loans in credit are interest free. The loans are unsecured with no fixed terms of repayment.

During the year the maximum amount outstanding on the overdrawn directors loan account for A & S Sedman was £24,568 (2012 - £25,347).

Included in other creditors is a loan due to A & S Sedman, directors of the company, of £22,650 (2012 £19,915 due from A & S Sedman was included in other debtors).
