

ORDER

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Administrators

AND UPON READING the witness statement of Ronald Robinson

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1 the administration order in relation to the Company dated 29/11/2000 be discharged pursuant to section 18 of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("**Act**"),
- 2 Ronald Robinson and Paul Stanley be released as administrators from all liability pursuant to section 20 of the Act with effect from the date 28 days after the filing of their final receipts and payments account unless within that period any application is made to discharge or vary this paragraph of this order,

AND UPON THE COURT BEING SATISFIED on the evidence that the EC Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings (Council Regulation (EC) No 1346/2000) does apply and that the winding up proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the Regulation

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1 service and advertisement of the petition be dispensed with,
- 2 the Company be wound up by the court under the provisions of the Act,
- 3 the costs of and incidental to this application be paid as an expense of the administration
